

# 10 ways to live more sustainably in Lane Cove

## 1. SEEK



Say NO THANKS to plastic shopping bags at the supermarket, deli, butcher and grocer. Be a shining example.

## 2. ASK



Ask for a paper bag instead, bring your own shopping bags, bring your own clean plastic containers to help to reduce plastic bags in landfill.

## 3. BRING



Bring your spare bags from home (not plastic) to the BAGSHARE bins near the fruit shop underneath Coles, for other shoppers to re-use. Share the love.

## 4. REDUCE



Reduce your purchase of items in plastic containers, recycle plastic containers into the yellow recycling bin after removing lids, labels and food debris.

## 5. DISCARD



Discard all plastic bags and wrap as rubbish. Household recycling bins are NOT for plastic bags.

## 6. DONATE



Donate preloved books and DVDs to the Lifeline Book Bin (a white Otto bin) at York's Corner shops, to the Lane Cove library, Vinnies, or the After a Fashion shop.

## 7. FIND



Find the dry cleaners in Lane Cove that re-use wire coat hangers. Find places to take used print cartridges. Dispose of mobile phones at the Library or Council chambers.

## 8. HELP



Be aware of our Lane Cove River environment, pick up plastic bottles and aluminium cans you see in the gutters, take them to a recycling bin. Take part in local bush care and regeneration programs. Get involved.

## 9. DRINK



Don't buy bottled water. It is just one more plastic container! Bring your reusable cup to buy take away hot drinks. Be a leader.

## 10. PLAY



Savour the natural beauty of the river, trees, parks and bushland of Lane Cove every day. Walk, cycle, kayak, join bushcare, or take your kids to playgrounds more often than before.

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
